

Full time Positions as ILO/IPEC Evaluation specialists

Evaluators with experience in managing and implementing international development evaluations

The International Programme on the Elimination of Child Labour (IPEC) of the International Labour Organisation (ILO) is looking for two full-time *evaluation specialists*, one at **senior level** (secured funding) and one at **less senior level** (pending funding) to manage and implement international development evaluations.

IPEC is one the largest technical cooperation programme in the United Nations system with a portfolio of over 100 projects in over 80 countries, over 20 donors and with planned spending for 2008-09 in excess of US \$ 100 million.

We are looking for evaluation professionals with international experience in planning, managing and conducting evaluations; extensive facilitation, training and strategic planning experience; and exposure to knowledge management. For the senior position we are looking for at least 10 years experience. Supervision of other evaluation specialists and outside evaluators is a key part of the job. Experience from work in an evaluation unit in an international oriented organisation would be preferred.

Preference will be given to evaluation specialist able to work in Spanish. The position is at United Nations P4 level for the senior specialist and P3 level for the less senior position, located at ILO/IPEC headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland with some travel to regions.
