Evaluation of UNESCO's work in Technical and Vocational Education and Training (Component 1 and/or 2).

The evaluation team is seeking two profiles:

- Extensive knowledge of the global TVET arena and senior international expertise in TVET (Component 1)
- Extensive knowledge of development evaluation, including in the area of education (Component 2)

A balanced combination of these qualifications is being sought within the evaluation team. Candidates may apply for one or both components.

Main deliverables:

- *Inception Report*
- *Draft Evaluation Report*
- *Final Evaluation Report*

The evaluation will be conducted between December 2014 and May 2015 and is estimated to take up 30-40 working days for each of the two profiles.
