Calling all researchers and practitioners in impact evaluation and research uptake!

We are delighted to announce a call for proposals to commission £9.5 million of research projects, seeking innovations in impact evaluation and evidence synthesis for international development.

Be part of an innovative research agenda

Over the past year, the Centre of Excellence for Development Impact and Learning (CEDIL) has identified key gaps in the impact evaluation and evidence synthesis fields and explored some of the most promising areas for future innovation. We have designed three programmes of work to drive this agenda forward and are now looking for innovative projects which fit these themes:

- Understanding complex interventions
- Generalising evidence through middle range theory
- Enhancing the use and usefulness of evaluation findings



The commissioned projects will last between 1 and 3 years; will range in value from under £100,000 to £1 million; and will include evaluations, secondary data analysis evidence synthesis and exploratory projects.

Who we are looking for and how to apply

We welcome proposals from research and evaluation teams based in legally established organisations anywhere in the world, and strongly encourage participation from organisations in the Global South. The projects are particularly appropriate for teams at academic research organisations, but proposals from NGOs and private companies are also welcomed.
